Austria 5kr registered entire uprated with 1890-96, 5kr Rose, 10kr Ultramarine, tied by Trieste Jun. 3, 1897 and addressed to Massawa, Eritrea, cover returned to Rome, then resent once again to Massawa for a second time, two strikes of "Poste Italiane Aden-Massaua" boxed datestamps, one for each attempt and dated Jun. 16 and Jul. 21, Rome backstamp, Very Fine and remarkable cover, the only recorded cover having been sent on this voyage twice, this line was set up by the Italian Post Office for mail to/from Massawa and operated by the Rubattino shipping company lines which ran a weekly service. Tied by Kamaran Dec. 1930 double-circle datestamp on legal sized O.H.M.S. cover to Steamer Point, Aden, clear strike of violet "Quarantine Station, Kamaran" handstamp, slight edge wear, otherwise Very Fine, Indian Official stamps used in Aden are quite scarce with a use from Kamaran rarely seen, only two strikes of this Quarantine Station handstamps are known
