Oct. 18, 1854 box despatch datestamp on back (affected by placement over flaps), red "INDIA PAID" handstamp ties strip, red "D.A.a.L." handstamp, Genoa arrival backstamp, the strip was applied over the left edge of cover and severed upon opening, but miraculously leaving the single and strip of three intact VERY FINE COVER TO ITALY WITH A STRIP OF THREE AND SINGLE OF THE 2-ANNAS TYPOGRAPH. A VERY EARLY USE, JUST UNDER TWO WEEKS AFTER ISSUE. The 2a Typograph was issued on October 4, 1854.
